

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT

FACULTY OF MEDICINE - RETURNING POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST (TST)

- As part of the annual Registration process, a **yearly One Step TST is required**.
- Students previously tested with a positive result should not receive a TST.
- TST must be completed prior to any live vaccine such as MMR or Varicella; if not it is otherwise invalid.
- A history of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for a TST.
- TST is available at Health Service on campus or to the occupational health services of the hospital where you have been assigned to.
- TST is recommended 3 months post travel to any endemic area.
