#### TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST (TST)

- As part of the annual registration process, a **yearly One Step TST is required.**
- TST must be completed prior to any live vaccine such as MMR or Varicella; if not the test is invalid.
- A history of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for a TST.
- TST is recommended 3 months post travel to any endemic area.
- If you previously had a positive TST, future testing is not required but the **Tuberculosis Signs and Symptoms form is required on an annual basis.**
